



**Overseas Immersion Programme Agreement between
Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts, Singapore and Faculty of Performing Arts (Theatre, Dance,
Pedalangan, Karawitan)
Institut Seni Indonesia (ISI) Yogyakarta**

Overseas Immersion Programme is a 3-week cultural and educational engagement programme, hosted by an academic institution, with the aim to broaden students' outlook and approach to the arts and to learn and experience traditional theatre practices.

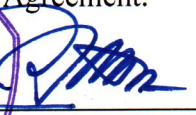
The scope and procedural details of the Agreement are as stated below:

1. Objectives
 - a. Hosting of NAFA faculty members
 - b. Hosting of NAFA students
 - c. Exchange of academic and scholarly information
 - d. Other activities deemed appropriate by mutual consent
2. Duration of the Agreement
 - a. This Agreement will take effect from the date signed by the duty designated officials of the respective institutions. The effective period is for 1 year.
 - b. Should either institution wish to terminate this Agreement, written notice should be given three months in advance of the desired termination date.
3. Liaison and Administration
 - a. Financial arrangements, e.g., the hosting of students, faculty members, and learning stipulations are to be clearly detailed in separate addendum.
 - b. Modifications and/or amendments to this Agreement can only be executed by mutual consent.

**Addendum to the Overseas Immersion Programme Agreement between
Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts, Singapore and Faculty of Performing Arts (Theatre, Dance,
Pedalangan, Karawitan)
Institut Seni Indonesia (ISI) Yogyakarta**

Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA), Singapore, will send their students to Institut Seni Indonesia (ISI) Yogyakarta, for an Overseas Immersion within the valid period of the Agreement, in accordance with the following conditions:

1. The length of the programme will be for a total number of 3 weeks and NAFA staff and students will be at ISI Yogyakarta from 2 - 19 July 2025.
2. NAFA plans to bring 18 students for the Overseas Immersion.
3. NAFA students must have completed their first year of study to be eligible to participate in the Overseas Immersion.
4. NAFA and ISI Yogyakarta will each assign a member of staff to take charge and administer the NAFA Overseas Immersion.
5. NAFA will assign 2 lecturers to accompany and assist in facilitating classes for the NAFA students throughout the Overseas Immersion.
6. NAFA will be responsible for organising and arranging international transportation as required.
7. ISI Yogyakarta will be responsible for providing the following:
 - Inland transportation, including return transportation from airport to accommodation and from accommodation to ISI Yogyakarta
 - Accommodation at Gallery Prawirotaman Hotel
 - Lecturers and studio spaces for 60 hours of workshops in four different traditional performing art forms, including theatre, dance, karawitan (gamelan), and puppetry according to the attached schedule and specifications
 - Lecturers and appropriate spaces for the rehearsals and performance of the milestone showcase according to the attached schedule and specifications
 - Costumes, make-up, props, and production and technical support for the milestone showcase

- Lecturers to co-assess the milestone showcase with NAFA lecturers
 - Transportation and tickets to a performance of Ramayana Ballet, Kraton, and Prambanan Temple.
 - One additional studio that can accommodate 40 persons for NAFA's use to conduct discussions and classes for NAFA students during the course of the programme
8. International transportation, cost of living or other personal expenses incurred by NAFA students, will be the responsibility of the individual students.
9. Financial Payments

- ISI Yogyakarta will charge NAFA a fee of IDR 281,100,000,-
 - NAFA will pay ISI Yogyakarta a deposit of IDR 10 million to secure the accommodation reservation by Monday, 19th May 2025
 - NAFA will pay ISI Yogyakarta a deposit of IDR 5 million to secure the inland transportation reservation by Monday, 19th May 2025
 - NAFA will pay ISI Yogyakarta the balance of the fee by Monday, 23rd June 2025.
10. This agreement will only be confirmed and will take effect upon approval by both parties' signature on this agreement document.
