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With this Memorandum of Understanding between Faculty of Performing Arts, Institut Seni Indonesia Yogyakarta, Indonesia and the Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as “the parties”). Desiring to further develop cultural cooperation between the two educational institutions, convinced that the cooperation will contribute to the enhancement of relations and better mutual understanding between their respective educational institutions.

The primary purpose of this Memorandum is to promote academic collaboration between the Parties.

Term of Agreement

1. The parties shall encourage and promote cooperation in the fields of;

- Joint Exchange Cultural (Dance, Music and Fine Arts)
- Joint Exhibition Arts
- Joint Seminars and Conferences
- Exchange of Lecturers
- Exchange of Students
- Exchange research project / Creative project / Explicit knowledge
- Digital Library

Detail the activities in the framework of this Program will be agreed upon on a case by case basis.

2. This MOU will enter into effect on the date of its signature by both parties and will remain effective for Three (3) years. Either of the Participants may terminate the Memorandum of Understanding by giving Ninety (90) days prior notice in writing to the other educational institution.

3. This MOU is written in English languages, and each educational institution will keep one of two original copies, all text being equally valid. In case of divergence in the interpretation of the provision for this MOU, the English text will prevail.
